## 125/16 COUNTY COUNCILLORS' REPORT

The County Councillor advised members that the westbound carriageway of Burton Bridge would be repaired overnight between the 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> of August. There was also planned remedial work to the road surface in Hawfield Lane and speed humps in Church Hill Street. The yellow box on Newton Road at the junction at the bottom of Bearwood Hill had been repainted. The Neighbourhood Team were due to visit on 18<sup>th</sup> August to undertake minor remedial works.

# 126/16 BOROUGH COUNCILLOR'S REPORT

Councillor Fletcher reported that the Swan floral bed had been replanted following its redesign by local primary schools and had received a mixed reaction. It was agreed that the planting this year was exceptional and to write to the leader of the Council congratulating the whole team and in particular Paul Steed and Simon Hinks at the Greenhouse Centre.

The Market Hall now had a 90% occupancy following the introduction of cheaper rents and shorter leases.

Councillor Falkner reported that Andy Mason at the Borough was still pursuing the funding for the Newton Road planting scheme which could now cost up to £2000 more to clear all the trees. He advised that enforcement action was being taken to tidy up the land around the new residential home opposite the Sump P H.

# 127/16 NEIGHBOURHOOD RESOURCE CENTRE CO-ORDINATORS REPORT

The Administrator reported that the outdoor gym equipment was being installed on Canterbury Road Park. Both the luncheon club and the coffee morning sessions were going well at the Centre.

## 130/16 NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

The Clerk was making good progress working closely with the Borough's officers to amend the Draft Plan prior to the Parish Council undertaking the Regulation 14 possibly in September 2016. Members raised the issue of Vancouver Drive with the land being advertised for sale again by the Borough. It was agreed that were it to be developed it should be for affordable housing with part of the green space being retained.
