It was also noted that an appeal had been lodged against the enforcement notice in respect of the unauthorised vehicular access to the land south-east of Newton Road.

192/18 **FINANCIAL REPORT**

With regards to the need to set the budget for 2019/2020 members were made aware of the Government's Council Tax Support Grant of £3722 being cut by £368 from that previous. It was agreed to set the budget for 2019/20 at £83,200 with the precept set at a figure of £64,131.84 with the difference being met from grants and reserves. This would result in a Parish Council Tax Rate Freeze. This equates to £26.37 for an average Band D property or approximately 50 pence per week.

Resolved:

That the budget for 2019/2020 be set at £83,200 with the precept for 2019/2020 being set at £64,131.84.
